










**Traffic Safety Enforcement has declined**

Vulnerable road user deaths continue to rise to record-breaking numbers










## Number and Proportion of Officer-Reported Impaired Driver-Involved Fatalities (Percent of Total Fatalities)






## Number and Proportion of Officer-Reported Impaired Driver-Involved Serious Injuries (Percent of Total Serious Injuries)











#### Average Fatalities per Fatal Crash





## Number and Proportion of Speeding-Involved Fatalities (Percent of Total Fatalities)








#### Number and Proportion of Speeding-Involved Serious Injuries (Percent of Total Serious Injuries)





#### Number and Proportion of Unrestrained Fatalities (Percent of Total Fatalities)








#### Number and Proportion Unrestrained Serious Injuries (Percent of Total Serious Injuries)

An in-depth report analyzing linked fatal crash and toxicology data 2008-2016, 2014-2015 roadside surveys, and self-report surveys.


