FMCSA 2020 Violations



- · Cocaine and amphetamines also high
- · High cheating reported

A FMCSA Drug and Alcohol Clearinghouse summary report indicates a nearly 13% increase in the number of positive driver drug tests, with marijuana accounting for more than 53% of the total since Jan 6, 2020.

As of August, 87,438 drivers had at least one drug or alcohol violation.



- Officers Who Showed up to OSH Having Never Stopped a CMV: 90%
- Officers Who Stopped At LEAST One CMV During OSH: 100%
- · Day 2 Stats:
 - Sno Co: 47 CMVs Stopped A LANDSTAR
 - Seattle: 30 CMVs+ stopped, 1 CMV placed out of service, 2 DUI investigations, 2 DREs, seized meth, cannabis, alcohol, Mexican Prescription
- Monthly Reporting
