## ALCOHOL AND DRUG IMPAIRED DRIVING RESEARCH AND POLICY RECOMMENDATIONS


#### IMPAIRED DRIVING COUNTERMEASURES

- .05 Blood Alcohol Concentration (BAC) (NTSB's Most Wanted)
- Ignition Interlock Use and Compliance (NHTSA 5-Star)
- Mandatory Substance Abuse Assessments for DUI Offenders (NHTSA 5-Star)
- Roadside Oral Fluid Screening for Drugs (NTSB Recommends)
- Sobriety checkpoints (NHTSA 5-Star)




#### LOWER BAC PER SE LIMIT TO .05

- National Transportation Safety Board's "Most Wanted" strategy
- Drivers are impaired at 0.05
- Crash risk increases significantly starting at 0.05
- 0.05 laws result in11% reduction in alcohol-related fatal crashes
- 0.05 laws prevent impaired driving
- 0.05 laws do not decrease alcohol revenue



#### THE **COUNTRIES IN GREEN** HAVE BAC LIMITS OF 0.05 OR **LOWER**



84% of the Earth's population lives in countries, states, and provinces with BAC limits of 0.05 or below



#### WTSC RECOMMENDS: Adopt a .05 BAC *per se* limit

# STRATEGIES AND TECHNOLOGIES TO PREVENT AND RESPOND TO WRONG-WAY DRIVING CRASHES

#### WRONG-WAY DRIVERS

Nearly 60 percent of wrong-way drivers were determined to be impaired

Preventative technology includes:

- Alerts when cars enter ramps the wrong way
- Communicating with other drivers though flashing lights, variable message signs
- Broadcasting communications to other drivers through traffic management centers

#### WTSC RECOMMENDATION

 Measures to reduce impaired driving are likely to have the broadest impact.






