 - Provide tools, resources, and training to strengthen safety work



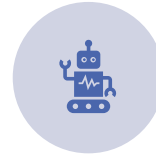

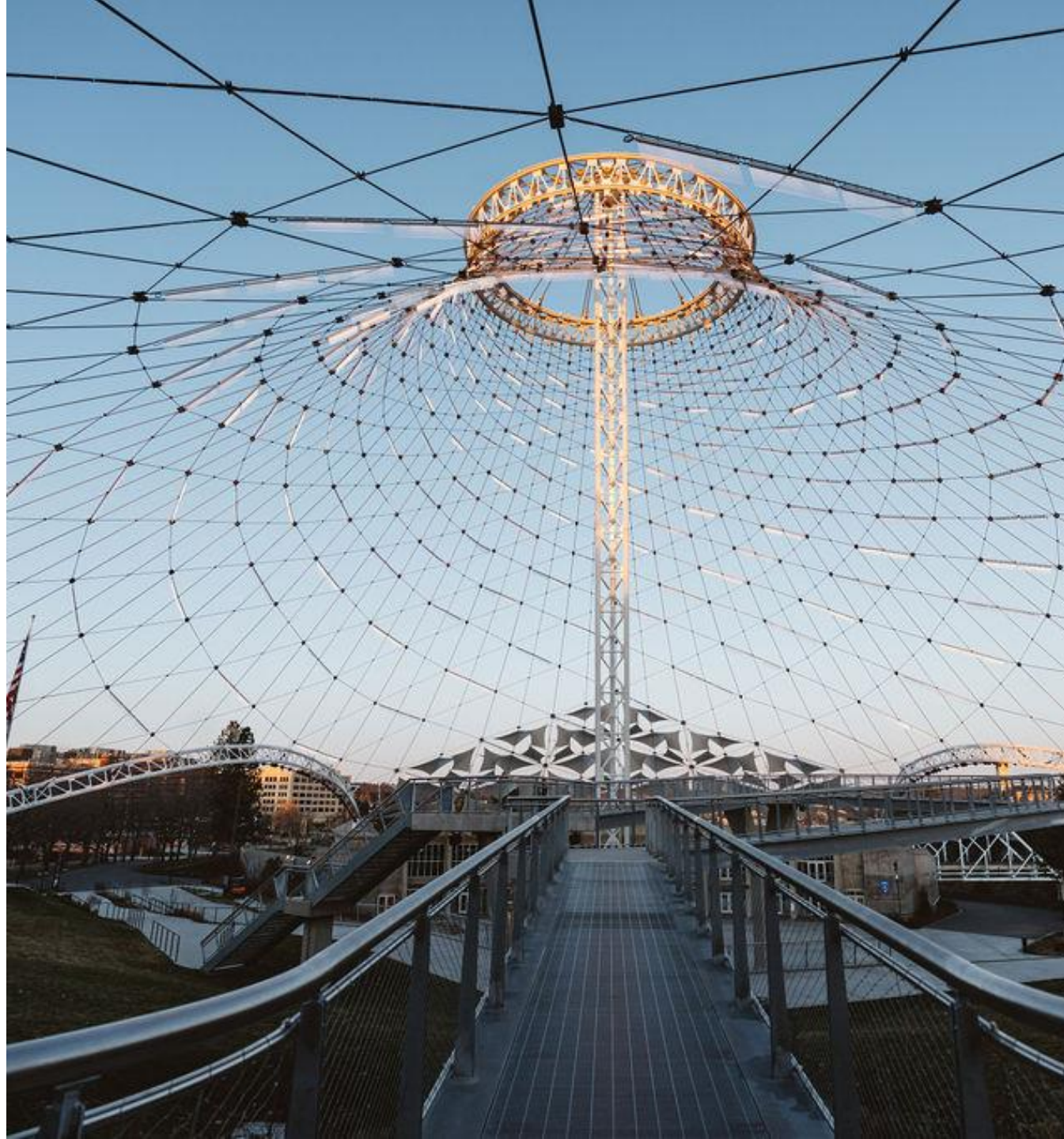
