Agenda Item:	SHSP Target Zero Update	Lead: John Flanagan
Action: John Flanagan reported that staff have a meeting with the Governor on January 20, 2020, to brief him on the SHSP. They will summarize the plan, explain where the state is trending, and update on past years numbers. The Governor's main points of interest are bikes and pedestrians along with necessary infrastructure investments, especially with I-976. They will discuss the four main policy recommendations out of the Target Zero Plan: Automated speed enforcement, regulations are novice and younger drivers, sobriety checkpoints, and infrastructure investments on things such as complete streets funding and highway projects that specifically address safety. Staff will also pitch ideas for this year that the Governor could, theoretically, implement even with the impacts of I-976. And finally, they will talk about things they feel they could start to pursue this session to start in 2021.		
Follow-Up: After the meeting with the Governor, he will loop back in with agencies and the commission to discuss other recommendations that could have greatest impacts beyond what is recommended in the Plan.
